CLINICAL PROGRAM BUILDING

- I have helped to develop and maintain a nationally recognized, integrated inpatient-partial hospital program for the treatment of eating disorders. The program is one of a handful of academic inpatient behavioral specialty programs for the treatment of eating disorders capable of treating eating disorders with severe medical co-morbidities as well as co-occurring psychiatric illnesses, including substance use disorders. I personally assisted with protocol revision, overseeing of staff and our domiciliary facility, fund raising and day to day management of the service.
- I was positioned as the sole consultation and liaison psychiatrist for the inpatient addiction services of Staten Island University Hospital which includes a chemical detoxification unit and a chemical dependence rehabilitation unit. For almost four years, I facilitated weekly classes educating patients on the neuroscience of addiction and the reward system of the brain, promoting the disease model of addiction and guided resident physicians in training through the process of doing the same. I also introduced medication assisted treatment where appropriate.
